Ophthalmology Assistant	9 months	Employed with UW Health for a min of 1 year. High school diploma or equivalency certificate. 2-year commitment at UW Health following your certification
Nursing Assistant	4-6 weeks	1-year commitment to UW Health upon completion. Website: https://careers.uwhealth.org/nursing-assistant- training-program/
Pharmacy Technician	18 weeks	Applicants must be 18 years of age (or 17 with requirements) High school diploma or equivalency certificate. 2-year commitment at UW Health following your certification Website: careers.uwhealth.org/pharmacy-technician-training- program/
