## User Experience Designer

## Tech Support Specialist

## Networking Technician

Technicians are responsible for troubleshooting and fixing hardware and software devices. They repair and upgrade the systems on their network. They learn about various operating systems like – Linux, Unix, Windows, etc. along with the basics of computer networking.
